You will also have the opportunity to give training sessions of your own and to explore new ways of training methods. You arrange the required training infrastructure (IT, rooms, catering,...) and the availability of training material. The follow-up of training sessions and guarding the quality will be your responsibility, by evaluating the sessions together with the trainers. You will continue to establish connections to international bioinformatics trainers (e.g. www.biotnet.org), and work on the visibility of BITS, towards the institute and towards the world.

You can count on administrative and communication support, and the assistance of other BITS members to succeed. To keep up your skills in the fast evolving area of bioinformatics, part of your time will be dedicated to assist in data mining at BITS. A lot of freedom to shape the bioinformatics training program at VIB to internationally renowned standards will be your share!



You will be employed in the Bioinformatics Training and Service (BITS) facility of the VIB. Training is one of BITS' core activities, besides data mining assistance to scientists and providing bioinformatics software at VIB.
